

Notification of the Ministry of Public Health

Re: The provision of a sign displaying the name and qualifications of a controller of manufacturing, import or sale of medical devices

BE. 2567 (2024)

Whereas it is appropriate to specify criteria, methods and conditions for providing signs displaying the names and qualifications of those who control the manufacturing, import or sales of medical devices

By virtue of Section 5, paragraph one of the Medical Devices Act, B.E. 2551 (2008), and Section 41(7) of the Medical Devices Act, B.E. 2551 (2008) and as amended (version 2) B.E. 2562 (2019), the Minister of Public Health issues the following statement:

Clause 1 This announcement shall come into force the day after its publication in the Royal Gazette onwards.

Clause 2 In accordance with the Ministry of Public Health's notification under Section 6 (7), it is required that a controller for manufacturing, importing, or selling medical devices be designated. The entrepreneur must display a sign with the name and qualifications of this controller in a visible area at the manufacturing, import, or sales location as indicated on the respective licenses. The sign must be made of permanent white material, not less than 20 centimeters wide and 50 centimeters long, with the controller's first name, surname, and qualifications written in blue Thai letters no smaller than 3 centimeters in height.

Clause 3 Any establishment/licensed/notified/listing license holder who registered prior to the effective date of this notification shall proceed to have a sign showing the name and qualifications of the person in charge of the manufacturing, import or sales controller according to Clause 2 within one year from the effective date of this notification
